Job 10:20-22 *“Are not my few days almost over? Turn away from me so I can have a moment’s joy before I go to the place of no return, to the land of gloom and deep shadow, to the land of deepest night, of deep shadow and disorder, where even the light is like darkness.”*

Job 16:16-21 *“O, earth do not cover my blood; may my cry never be laid to rest! Even now my witness is in heaven; my advocate is on high. My intercessor is my friend as my eyes pour out to God; on behalf of a man He pleads with God as a man pleads for his friend. Only a few years will pass before I go on the journey of return.”*

Job 22:23-30 *“If you return to the Lord Almighty, you will be restored; If you remove wickedness far from your tent and assign your nuggets to the dust, your gold of Ophir to the rocks and ravines, then the Almighty will be your gold, the choicest of silver for you. Surely then you will find delight in the Almighty and will lift up your face to God. You will pray to Him, and he will hear you, And you will fulfill your vows. Isa. 35:8-10 *“And a highway will be there; it will be called the way of Holiness. The unclean will not journey on it; it will be for those who walk in that Way; wicked fools will not go about on it. No lion will be there, nor will any ferocious beast get up on it; they will not be found there. But only the redeemed will walk there, and the ransomed of the Lord will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.”*

Isa. 55:10-11 *“As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is My word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to Me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.”*

Jer. 24:7 *“My eyes will watch over them for their good, and I will bring them back to this land. I will build them up and not tear them down; I will plant them and not uproot them. I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the Lord. They will be My people, and I will be their God, for they will return to Me with all their heart.”*

Jer. 31:7-9 *“Make your praises heard, and say, ‘O Lord save Your people, the remnant of Israel.’ See I will bring them from the land of the north and gather them from the ends of the earth. Among them will be the blind and the lame, expectant mothers and women in labor; a great throng will return. They will come with weeping; they will pray as I bring them back. I will lead them besides streams of water on a level path where they will not stumble, because I am Israel’s father and Ephraim is my firstborn son.”*

Lam. 3:40 *“Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the Lord. Let us lift up our hearts and hands to God in heaven, and say: ‘We have sinned and rebelled and you have not forgiven.’”*

Hos. 6:1 *“Come let us return to the Lord. He has torn us to pieces but He will heal us; He has injured us, but He will bind up our wounds.”*

Hos. 12:6 *“But you must return to your God; maintain justice, and wait for your God always.”*

Hos. 14:1 *“Return, O Israel, to the Lord your God. Your sins have been your downfall! Take words with you and return to the Lord. Say to Him: ‘Forgive all our sins and receive us graciously, that we may offer the fruit of our lips.’”*

Joel 2:12 *“Even now, declares the Lord, return to Me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning. Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and relents from sending calamity.”*

Zech. 1:3 *“The Lord was very angry with your forefathers. Therefore tell the people: This is what the Lord says: ‘Return to Me,’ declares the Lord Almighty, ‘and I will return to you, says the Lord Almighty. ‘Do not be like your forefathers, to whom the earlier prophets proclaimed: This is what the Lord Almighty says: ‘Turn from your evil ways and your evil practices. But they would not listen or pay attention to Me, declares the Lord.*

Zech. 10:7-9 *“The Ephraimites will become like mighty men, and their hearts will be glad as with wine. Their children will see it and be joyful; their hearts will rejoice in the Lord. I will signal for them and gather them in. Surely I will redeem them; they will be as numerous as before. Though I scatter them among the peoples, yet in distant lands they will remember Me. They and their children will survive, and they will return.”*
