Zerubbabel: (Nave's Topical Bible) also called Sheshbazzar, directs the rebuilding of the altar and temple after his return from captivity in Babylon (Ezra 3:2-8, 4:2-3, 5:2, 14-16, Haggai 1:12-14); leads the Emancipated Jews back from Babylon (Ezra 1:8-11, 2, Nehemiah 12); appoints the Levites to inaugurate the rebuilding of the Temple (Ezra 3:2-8); prophecies relating to Zerubbabel (Haggai 2:2, Zechariah 4:6-10); genealogy of Joseph (Matthew 2:2, Luke 3:27)

Establish: Strong's number 3559, "awk," "Hilphil" to establish, set up, accomplish, do, make firm, fix, make ready, prepare, provide, provide for, furnish, direct toward, arrange order

Joshua 1:11 "Go through the camp and tell the people, 'Get your supplies ready. Three days from now you will cross the Jordan here to go in and take possession of the land the LORD your God is giving you for your own.' "

Joshua 3:17 The priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the middle of the Jordan, while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing on dry ground.

1 Samuel 7:3 And Samuel said to the whole house of Israel, "If you are returning to the LORD with all your hearts, then rid yourselves of the foreign gods and the Ashtoreth's and commit yourselves to the LORD and serve him only, and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines."

2 Samuel 7:12-13, 16 When your days are over and you rest with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, who will come from your own body, and I will establish his kingdom. He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me; your throne will be established forever.' "

1 Chronicles 15:1, 3, 12 After David had constructed buildings for himself in the City of David, he prepared a place for the ark of God and pitched a tent for it...David assembled all Israel in Jerusalem to bring up the ark of the LORD to the place he had prepared for it...He said to them, "You are the heads of the Levitical families; you and your fellow Levites are to consecrate yourselves and bring up the ark of the LORD, the God of Israel, to the place I have prepared for it.

1 Chronicles 17:11-12, 14, 24 When your days are over and you go to be with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. He is the one who will build a house for me, and I will establish his throne forever...I will set him over my house and my kingdom forever; his throne will be established forever.' "...so that it will be established and that your name will be great forever. Then men will say, 'The LORD Almighty, the God over Israel, is Israel's God!' And the house of your servant David will be established before you.

2 Chronicles 3:1 Then Solomon began to build the temple of the LORD in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where the LORD had appeared to his father David. It was on the threshing floor of Araunah ^[a] the Jebusite, the place provided by David.

2 Chronicles 19:3 There is, however, some good in you, for you have rid the land of the Asherah poles and have set your heart on seeking God."

2 Chronicles 29:36 Hezekiah and all the people rejoiced at what God had brought about for his people, because it was done so quickly.

2 Chronicles 35:4, 6,10,14-16, 20 Prepare yourselves by families in your divisions, according to the directions written by David king of Israel and by his son Solomon...Slaughter the Passover lambs, *consecrate* yourselves and prepare the lambs for your fellow countrymen, doing what the LORD commanded through Moses."... The service was arranged and the priests stood in their places with the Levites in their divisions as the king had ordered... After this, they made preparations for themselves and for the priests, because the priests, the descendants of Aaron, were sacrificing the burnt offerings and the fat portions until nightfall. So the Levites made preparations for themselves and for the Aaronic priests. The musicians, the descendants of Asaph, were in the places prescribed by David, Asaph, Heman and Jeduthun the king's seer. The gatekeepers at each gate did not need to leave their posts, because their fellow Levites made the preparations for them. So at that time the entire service of the LORD was carried out for the celebration of the Passover and the offering of burnt offerings on the altar of the LORD, as King Josiah had ordered. After all this, when Josiah had set the temple in order, Neco king of Egypt went up to fight at Carchemish on the Euphrates, and Josiah marched out to meet him in battle.

Proverbs 24:3, 27 By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established;...Finish your outdoor work and get your fields ready; after that, build your house.

Isaiah 2:2 In the last days the mountain of the LORD's temple will be established as chief among the mountains; it will be raised above the hills, and all nations will stream to it.

Isaiah 9:7 Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.

Isaiah 16:5 In love a throne will be established; in faithfulness a man will sit on it— one from the house of David— one who in judging seeks justice and speeds the cause of righteousness.

Isaiah 62:6-7 I have posted watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they will never be silent day or night. You who call on the LORD, give yourselves no rest, and give him no rest till he establishes Jerusalem and makes her the praise of the earth.

Jeremiah 51:12 Lift up a banner against the walls of Babylon! Reinforce the guard, station the watchmen, prepare an ambush! The LORD will carry out his purpose, his decree against the people of Babylon.

Ezekiel 4:3 Then take an iron pan, place it as an iron wall between you and the city and turn your face toward it. It will be under siege, and you shall besiege it. This will be a sign to the house of Israel.

Ezekiel 38:7 Get ready; be prepared, you and all the hordes gathered about you, and take command of them.

Hosea 6:3 Let us acknowledge the LORD; let us press on to acknowledge him. As surely as the sun rises, he will appear; he will come to us like the winter rains, like the spring rains that water the earth."

Amos 4:12 "Therefore this is what I will do to you, Israel, and because I will do this to you, prepare to meet your God, O Israel."

Micah 4:1 In the last days the mountain of the LORD's temple will be established as chief among the mountains; it will be raised above the hills, and peoples will stream to it.
